Our Services

ICAN provides equipment demonstrations, trainings, and presentations to individuals, family members, employers, educators, and professionals.

Training

We provide training on specific devices, such as Dynavox, Vanguard, and augmentative communication devices for individuals with autism. All of the scheduled training opportunities are listed on the training calendar on our website, www.ar-ican.org.

Loan Program

We loan a wide range of assistive technology devices to individuals so that they can try out a device before

purchasing or use it in a temporary time of need, such as, when a device is being repaired or if it will be needed only for a short period of time. Wheelchairs, standers, and walkers require a prescription from a doctor or therapist. Augmentative and Alternative Communication (ACC) devices over \$3,000 can be checked out only by a speech and language therapist or an occupational therapist. To check out a device, a valid state ID is required.

Tours

ICAN welcomes the public to tour our technology clearinghouse at 525 W. Capitol Avenue in downtown Little Rock. Virtual tours are available at www.ar-ican.org. Touring the **ICAN** facility in person offers the best opportunity to learn about the technology available for individuals with disabilities.

Eligibility

ICAN's products and services are available to all Arkansans with disabilities without regard to age, disability,

income, geographic area, or eligibility for any other program.
