**ACCREDITATION STANDARDS FOR 2008-09**

The Standards of Accreditation of Public Schools require that each school offer three programs of study in three different occupational areas. If a program is offered at a secondary vocational center, students must be enrolled in the 2008-09 school year.

**ACADEMIC SKILL ATTAINMENT**

The academic attainment measure is based on the number of CTE concentrators who score proficient or advanced on the end-of-course Literacy and Geometry assessments. CTE concentrators are those students who have completed at least three units from a program of study in grades 9-12 and are leaving the secondary education system during the reporting year.

**CTE SKILL ATTAINMENT**

CTE Skill Attainment is based on the number of CTE concentrators who score proficient on the CTE competency tests (70% is the proficient level).

PCT of concentrators proficient: 62.07% State Target: 57.50% State Average: 54.31%  
District rating: Met State Target

Another factor in CTE Skill Attainment is the average score for all students tested during the year.

District average score: 74.66% State Target: 70% State Average: 67.72%

**GRADUATION**

The graduation rate for concentrators is based on the number of students identified as concentrators the beginning of their senior year (completed at least three units in one occupational area) compared with the number of those who graduated.

PCT of concentrators graduated: 94.44% State Target: 86% State Average: 89.9%

**PLACEMENT**

Placement is based on the status of completers six months following graduation. Completers who pursued opportunities in postsecondary education, the workforce, or military are considered positive placements.

PCT positive placement: 94.87% State Target: 94.71% State Average: 94.94%

**COMPLETERS OF PROGRAM STUDY**

A completer is a graduate who successfully completed three or more units of credit within a program of study, including all the core requirements for that program of study. There are two measures for this indicator. The first is the number of completers compared to the number of graduates. The second is the number of seniors enrolled in career and technical classes compared to the number of completers.
