A proposed revision to the Program Policies for the Administration of the GED® Test will be on public review in Room 209 of the Department of Career Education at Three Capitol Mall, Little Rock, during regular business hours from February 12 to March 12, 2016. The policy is regarding the recalibration of GED® Test cut scores. Original Policy

Effective January 1, 2014, the requirements to pass the GED® test are a minimum score of 150 on each test in the battery AND a total score of 600.

Individuals receiving an Arkansas High School Diploma must attain a minimum standard score of 150 on each of the four subtests and a total score of 600 on the GED® test.

Mark-Up Policy

The Adult Education Division of the Arkansas Department of Career Education will set scoring requirements for GED® testing based on GED® data, policy and research analysis and shall report any changes to the board at the next scheduled board meeting.
