The State Board of Career Education (SBCE) was called to order by Chairman Phil Taylor. The meeting was held at Arkansas Rehabilitation Services, 525 W. Capitol Avenue, Little Rock, Arkansas.

Director Walker introduced the newest board member, Mrs. Margarita Solórzano, and Mrs. Susan Harriman from the Department of Education.

Mr. Carl Daugherty, Arkansas Rehabilitation Services (ARS) Division chief of field services, introduced Mrs. Christie Bartlett, manager of the Jonesboro and Batesville field office; Mrs. Carol Etheridge, manager of the Fayetteville and Harrison field offices; and Mr. Sterling Hughes, manager of the Pine Bluff and Monticello field offices.

Dr. Robert Gunter, deputy director for career and technical education, introduced Mr. Ray Henson as the new associate director of workforce training.

A. ACTION ITEM – APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF AUGUST 2, 2012

On a motion by Mr. Riggs and second by Mrs. Dixon, the State Board of Career Education unanimously approved the minutes of August 2, 2012.

B. ACTION ITEM – ADOPTION OF THE 2012-2013 AGENCY BUDGET – DEPARTMENT OF CAREER EDUCATION

Mrs. Lorna Claudio, deputy director of finance, recommended that the State Board of Career Education approve the 2012-2013 budget as presented.

Mrs. Claudio provided the board members with the following major budget components:

Public School Fund – Adult basic and general adult education, workforce coordinators/counselors, new program start-up, adult literacy, and vocational center aid (state funds)

Agency Operations (state funds)

Federally Funded Programs – federal vocational, Veterans Approving Agency and adult education

Cash-Supported Operations – Verizon Award, Law Enforcement Support Office (LESO), and alternate retirement programs

Mrs. Claudio stated that the budget components funded with state appropriation were developed in a manner consistent with the requirements of the Revenue Stabilization Act and are based on official forecasts.

Mrs. Claudio reminded the board members that budgets are subject to change because of changes in actual revenues, receipts of miscellaneous grants, and authorized reallocation of funds among appropriations and line items. The approved budget will constitute authority to spend in a manner consistent with applicable state and federal laws and regulations. The director of the Department of Career Education is authorized to make appropriate corrections and adjustments in accordance with policies and procedures established by the State Board of Career Education.

On motion by Mr. Riggs and second by Mrs. Dixon, the State Board of Career Education unanimously approved the adoption of the 2012-2013 agency budget.

C. ACTION ITEM – APPROVAL OF BIENNIAL BUDGET REQUEST FOR 2013-2015 – DEPARTMENT OF CAREER EDUCATION

Mrs. Lorna Claudio, deputy director for finance, recommended that the State Board of Career Education approve the budget request for the 2013-2015 biennium.

Mrs. Claudio stated that ACE is requesting substantial increases in appropriation and funding for the 2013-2015 biennium in an effort to provide equitable and adequate educational opportunities to Arkansans.

On motion by Mr. Riggs and second by Mrs. Dixon, the State Board of Career Education unanimously approved the biennial budget request for 2013-2015.

D. ACTION ITEM – ADOPTION OF THE 2013 OPERATIONAL BUDGET – ARKANSAS REHABILITATION SERVICES

Mr. Joseph Baxter, ARS chief financial officer, recommended that the State Board of Career Education approve the 2013 operational budgets as presented

Mr. Baxter provided the board members with the following major budget components:

Operational Budget – Highlights

Mr. Baxter stated that the operational budget is based on estimates of several revenue sources, including vocational rehabilitation, supported employment, independent living, technology access programs, social security reimbursements, stimulus funding, special revenue, general revenue, and various cash funds. The following schedule summarizes these funds:

Mr. Baxter also provided information for special projects that are expected to be funded as part of the SFY2013 budget expenditures:

Arkansas Career Training Institute (ACTI) Water/Hydrant Repair - \$500,000
 ACTI Armory Renovations - \$200,000

On motion by Mr. Riggs and second by Mrs. Dixon, the State Board of Career Education unanimously approved the Arkansas Rehabilitation Services request for the 2013 operational budget.

E. ACTION ITEM – APPROVAL OF THE 2013-2015 BIENNIAL BUDGET REQUEST – ARKANSAS REHABILITATION SERVICES

Mr. Joseph Baxter, ARS chief financial officer, recommended that the State Board of Career Education approve the budget request for the 2013-2015 biennium.

Mr. Baxter stated that ARS is requesting increases in appropriation and funding for the 2013-2015 biennium in keeping with ongoing efforts to improve the facilities at ACTI and to modify the soon-to-be acquired armory in Hot Springs to expand the client services in that area.

On motion by Mr. Riggs and second by Mrs. Dixon, the State Board of Career Education unanimously approved the biennial budget request for 2013-2015.

INFORMATION/RATIONALE: The satellite request is to locate a Health Science Technology Program on the Murfreesboro Campus of Cossatot Community College that will serve students from Kirby High School, which is approximately 15 miles from the Murfreesboro Cossatot Community College campus and 1 mile from Murfreesboro High School.

SUBJECT: INFORMATION ITEM – Request for a satellite location for Arkansas Tech University Career Center in the Health Science Technology Program of Study to be located on the Clarksville High School campus.

INFORMATION/RATIONALE: The satellite request is to locate a Health Science Technology Program on the Clarksville High School campus, which is approximately 30 miles from the Russellville Center and would allow students from Clarksville and Lamar School Districts who are currently served minimally due to travel distance to Russellville. In addition to Clarksville and Lamar students being served more efficiently, this satellite would also extend offerings to Scranton and Johnson County Westside students who are not currently being served by any secondary career center due to driving distance being outside the 25 mile radius allowed by ACE. In serving these underserved or non-served ATCC hopes to help alleviate some of the inequitable distribution of service areas.
