Eligibility Criteria

Arkansas residents who are United States citizens, plan to enroll or are enrolled full-time in an approved technical program, demonstrate leadership capabilities, and meet certain academic criteria are eligible to apply. Preference will be given to applicants who are graduating high school seniors. Applicants will be considered if they possess the following academic qualifications:

1. A minimum high school grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale based on seven semesters.
2. A minimum ACT composite score of 19 or a minimum score of 730 on the SAT combined verbal and math if the ACT score is not available or ranking in the upper ten percent of high school graduating class.

The application deadline for the 2015-2016 academic year is July 1, 2015. The scholarship may be renewed if the recipient remains a full-time student in good standing and has achieved a 3.0 grade-point average on a 4.0 grade scale. **Scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis.**
