Perkins Improvement Activity Equipment List

Description of Activity: A semester course designed to develop leadership skills, promote volunteerism, and strengthen school and community awareness.

Curriculum Component: A State and Nationally Affiliated FCCLA chapter is required along with an approved program of study in an FACS area. The course must be taught for a total of 5 years after the addition of this activity.

Equipment Component: Estimated cost should not exceed \$7,000

Presentation Software	Compatible with laptop and purchased equipment. Capable of producing original presentations and modifying pre-loaded presentations. Must include a variety of graphics and fonts and be able to incorporate stored pictures.	\$100
Computerized Presentation Board	Multi-function, portable, compatible with laptop and presentation software. Must include stand and protective carry/storage case.	\$1,500
Mobile tablet	Touch-screen controlled tablet computer with camera, 16 GB, wifi and cellular	\$600
Classroom Projector	Compatible with software, existing computers, and Computerized Presentation Board.	\$1,000
Portable Projector	Portable with carry case	\$400
