

**District Status Report for 2013-14****ACADEMIC SKILL ATTAINMENT**

The academic attainment measure is based on the number of CTE concentrators who score proficient or advanced on the end-of-course Literacy and Geometry assessments. CTE concentrators are those students who have completed at least three units from a program of study in grades 9-12 and are leaving the secondary education system during the reporting year.

**GRADUATION**

The graduation rate for concentrators is based on the number of students identified as concentrators at the beginning of their senior year (completed at least two units in one occupational area) compared with the number of those who graduated.

**PLACEMENT**

Placement is based on the status of completers six months following graduation. Completers who pursued opportunities in postsecondary education, the workforce, or military are considered positive placements.

**COMPLETION**

CTE concentrators leaving the secondary system during the reporting year who are reported as graduated or who receive a GED diploma.

Students enrolled in a minimum of one unit in a program of study determined to be nontraditional for their gender.

CTE concentrators who graduate and who complete the requirements for a program of study that is nontraditional for their gender.
