LITTLE ROCK – Everyone knows a better education can lead to higher wages, but when adults think about going back to school so they can move forward in their life and career, they're often faced with roadblocks.

They might have a job and can't get off work to take classes. They might have to take care of their kids. And they never seem to have enough money.

"Go Back. Move Forward," the Arkansas education resource guide for adults, was created to help adults get the resources they need to go back to school so they can move forward with their job skills and their education. It includes information on basic adult education programs, English as a Second Language classes, GED tests, colleges and universities, financial aid, day care, rehabilitation services and workforce services.

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It also includes success stories of Arkansans who went back to school. They all had reasons for dropping out of high school, not continuing with college, not taking the next step. But they all turned their lives around when they made a commitment to themselves and to their families to go back to school. Many of them had to start with the basics. Some had to overcome disabilities. But they all made it.

“Go Back. Move Forward” is the result of a state multi-agency effort that is part of the Pathways to Advancement project of the National Governors Association Center for Best Practices.
